




It takes a comprehensive, long-term perspective and promotes partnerships for integrated and regional solutions that leverage different sources of funding and financial instruments. Through this approach, the AfDB seeks to maximize the impact of its resources and support transformative change in vulnerable institutions, communities, and economies.







(5) Edit the Preliminary Project Concept (PPC)
